Classes are conducted on-campus during the following times:

Day	Grades 6 – 11, IBDP
Monday – Thursday	8:00 am – 3:20 pm
Friday	8:00 am – 12:00 pm

- Please make arrangements for your children to be picked up and dropped off each day.
- Secondary students that arrive between 7:00 am and 7:50 am should go directly to the Secondary Cafeteria and not be in other areas of the School.
- Students can make their way to their classes after 7:50 am as the morning song is being played.
- Extracurricular activities (ECAs) will be conducted after school hours and will only begin on a later date after school commencement.

ORIENTATION DAY

The School Uniform consists of the following

- Formal Uniform
- Physical Education (PE) Attire
- Sweater (optional)

All students are required to observe and abide by the School's Uniform Policy; thus:

- All students are expected to wear the school uniform with pride and respect, according to the School Code of Conduct.
- All students are required to be in the uniform as stipulated by the School.
- Students should change to the appropriate Physical Education (PE) attire during PE classes as per their timetable.
- Students are required to be in appropriate school uniform when attending a school field trip.
- Students should purchase the school uniform from the School Bookshop (refer to School Bookshop info below).

Sweater (optional purchase): Students may only wear the school sweater. We do not permit students of any age to wear hoodies or non-SIS sweaters.

Shoes & Socks: Students are required to wear black and/or white sneakers/sports/school shoes with black and/or white socks to school. Other types of shoes, sandals and slippers are <u>not allowed</u>. Coloured shoe trimmings or coloured soles are not permitted.

BOOKSHOP & LEARNING MATERIALS

The School Bookshop located at the SIS USJ Campus stocks school uniforms, textbooks, learning materials such as stationeries, workbooks, and exercise books that are required for lessons at school.

DIGITAL DEVICES

All Grades 6 to 11 and IBDP students are required to have and use their individual laptop in their daily lessons. The laptop must have the minimum specifications below:

Operating System : Microsoft Windows 10 and above or Mac OS

Processor : Intel Core i5 and aboveMemory : 16GB RAM and above

Hard Drive : At least 500GB for SSD HDD drive

• Wireless : 802.11 a/b/g/n/ac wireless

eCAMPUS SYSTEM
